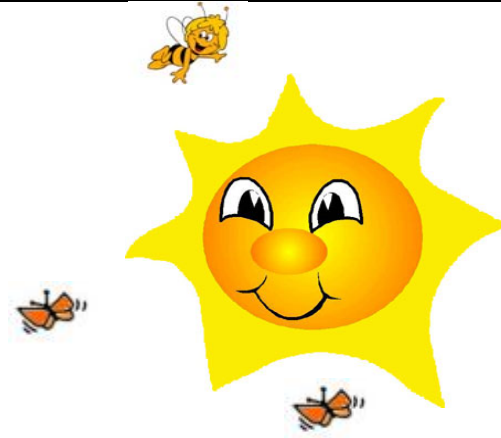
Inside Brenners Park-Hotel & Spa

Trip to the Elsass	
Affenberg in Alsace / France	A relaxing loop road will lead you to the center of a lovely forest. The area embraces about 24 hectares of land. Approximately 200 Barbary apes live here in true freedom. The Affenberg allows you to observe the apes from a very close distance. The visiting time is estimated to 1 hour per person. Opening hours: 10am - 12 noon / 1 pm - 5 pm Entrance fee: Children: 5,00 Euro / Adults: 8,00 Euro one hours drive by car 
Birds of prey farm	Right next to the Affenberg, a birds of prey farm provides its "stars" to the visitors. Events take place regularly. For further information, please contact our concierge.
Haut Königsbourg in Alsace / France	One of the most visited castles in France is Haute Königsbourg. The castle was built by Emperor Wilhelm II. following the classical style of architecture back in the 15th century. Especially the tower in the west of Haut Königsbourg will allow you a fantastic, breathtaking view over the black forest and the lowlands of the river Rhine. In insight the castle you will be able to admire a chapel, the cavaliers' room and antique furniture. Opening hours: 9.45 am - 12 noon / 2 pm - 5 pm Adults: 8,- Euro Children: free of charge one hours drive by car
